Why are we involved?


- Promoting worker participation is a key political priority for the ETUC, ETUFs and national trade union organisations

right to training

directive 2009/39/EC & CBA 101

In so far as this is necessary for the exercise of their representative duties in an international environment, the members of the SNB and of the EWC shall be provided with training without loss of wages.







